### **Art and Young Creators Camp Director**

**General Information:** The City of Arcata Recreation Division is now accepting applications for Art and Young Creators Camp Director. Planning and marketing activities to begin in April. Some hours are required in the spring for training, planning, and preparation. Camp programming runs from June 17 – Aug. 16, 2019. This is a seasonal position with the City of Arcata and does not include benefits.

**Applicant Qualifications:** As an Art Camp Director you will be responsible for working with your Co-Director to develop, and implement all Art Camp curriculum for children ages 4–6yrs (Young Creators Camp) and 7-12yrs (Art Camp). In addition, you will be responsible for supervising small and large groups of campers, communicating with parents, and maintaining your supplies and classroom. Camps take place at the Arcata Community Center. Applicants must have experience working with children along with a background in various artistic mediums and or crafts. Qualified applicants must be at least 18 years of age. CPR, and First Aid certification must be secured prior to the first day of camp along with Tuberculosis clearance. The City does provide CPR and First Aid training upon employment.

**Pay Range: \$12.426 - \$14.385 per hour**

**Program Hours and Shifts:** The camp is in session Monday-Friday from 1pm-5:30pm. Daily prep time occurs each day before campers arrive in addition to time for preparation and planning before June.
