Please include your name, age, school, and phone number on the back of the completed poster so we can contact you once contest winners are selected.

Completed posters can be turned in to your school or to Arcata City Hall - Environmental Services Department by Friday, April 29th by 5:00pm. Winners of the poster contest will be displayed at Arcata City Hall from May 2nd-May 31st and at the Farmer's Market Water Week table on Saturday, May 7th. Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in the following 4 divisions:
Pre K-Kindergarten, 1st-3rd Grade, 4th–6th Grade,
and 7th-12th Grade.
