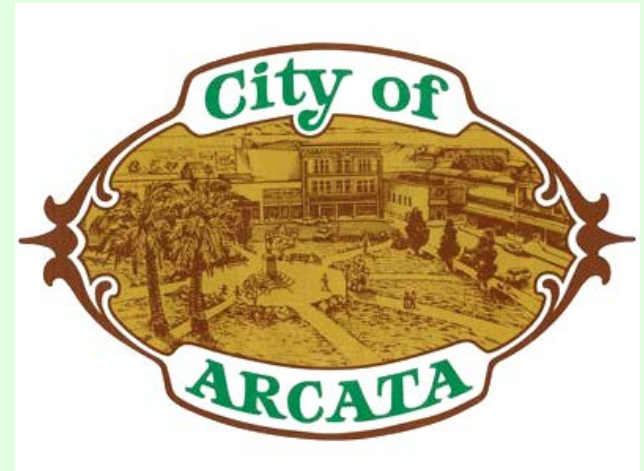

- Develop draft plans to assist with implementation fund seeking

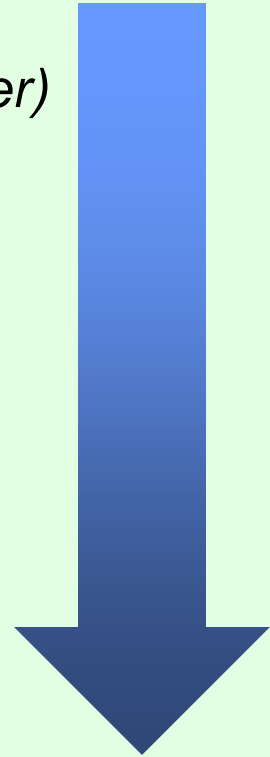




Old Arcata Road Design Project

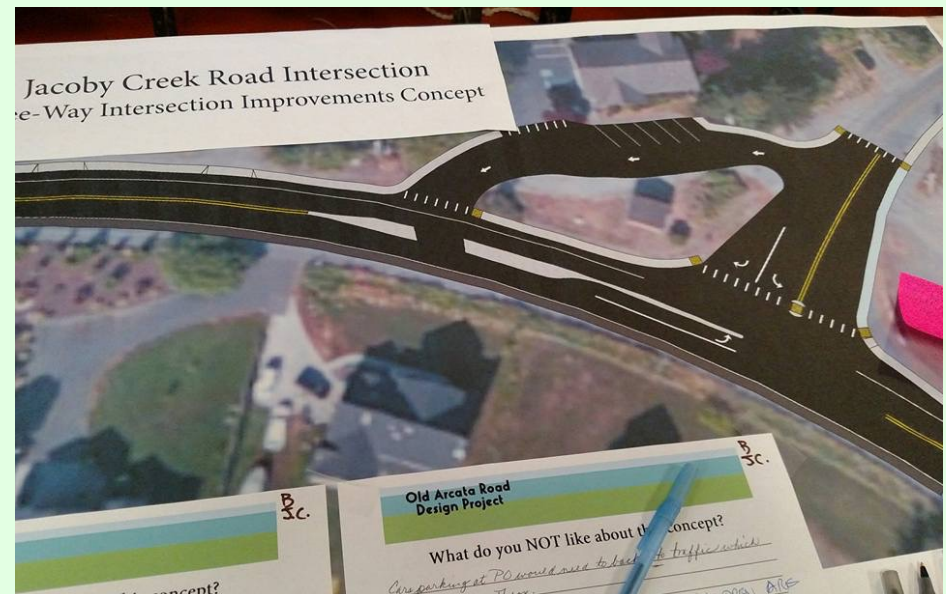

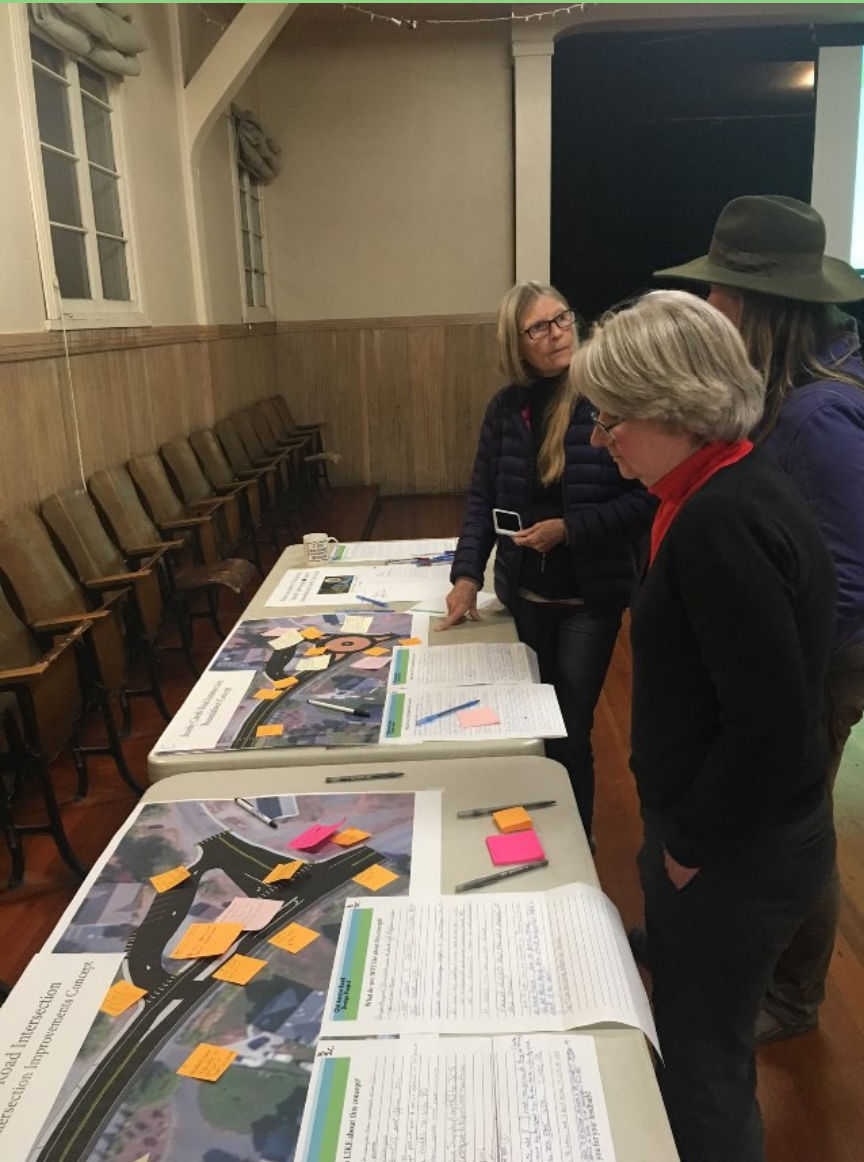
- 60+ attendees

Old Arcata Road Design Project

Desired Improvements

- Traffic calming
- Pedestrian walkways
- Double yellow centerline
- Safer crosswalks
- Pedestrian safety at school crossing
- Improved signage/pavement markings for school zones
- Improve Jacoby Creek Rd intersection
- Bike friendly improvements



Old Arcata Road Design Project

- Patched roadway
- Restriped roadway to narrow travel lanes & widen bike lanes
- New crosswalks soon at Golf Course Road and Anderson Lane
- School speed sign for Mistwood
- There has been a lot of positive feedback on these improvements!

Recent Maintenance



Concept Alternative #1: Leave as-is

- Improvements limited to current maintenance project
- Annual maintenance will continue
- < 10% of respondents wanted this alternative

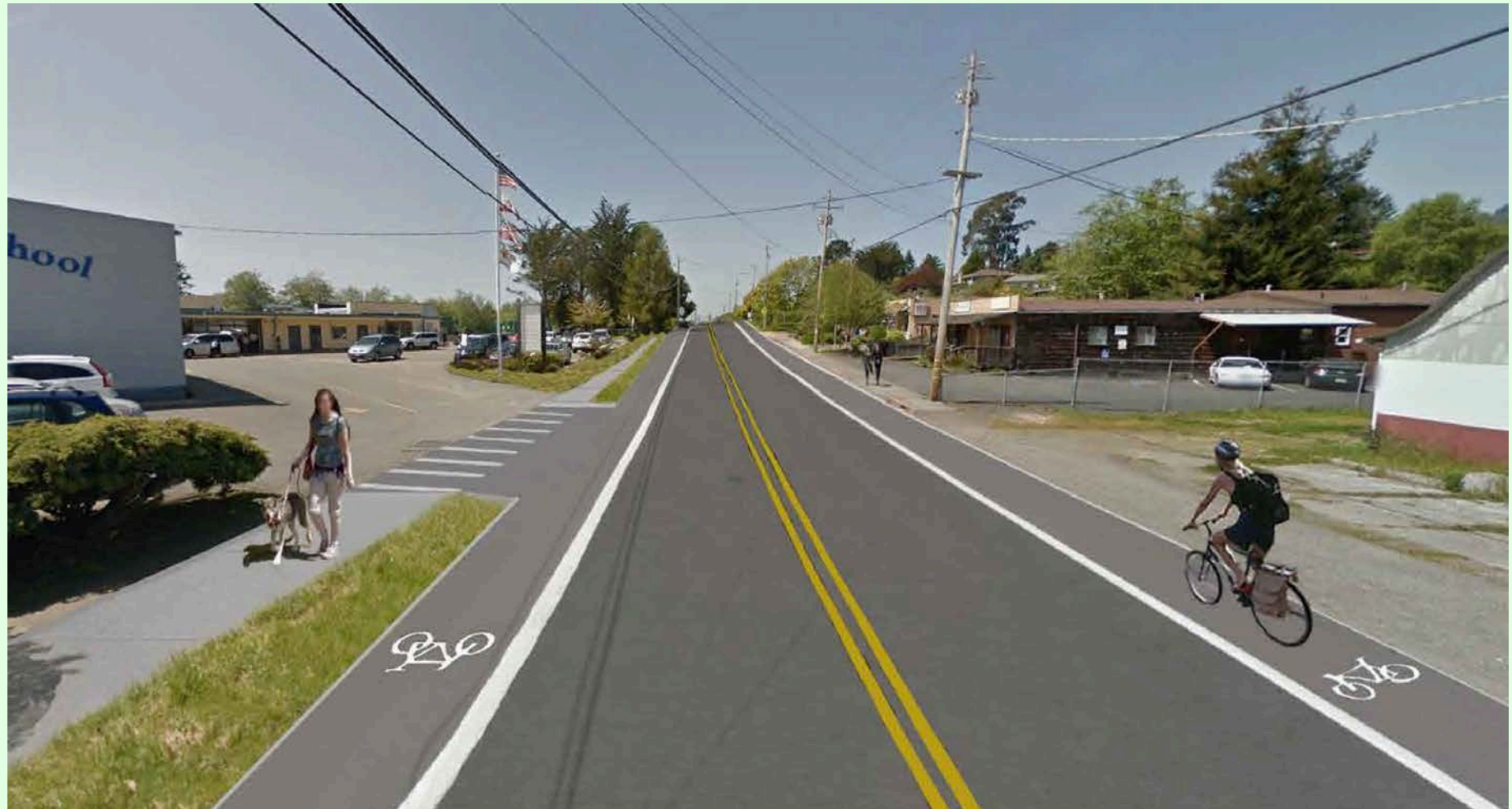
Concept Alternative #2: Separated Path

- Preferred by more than 60% of respondents
- Separated path along west side of Old Arcata Road for entire project length

Concept Alternative #3: Sidewalk in front of JC School

- Preferred by about 20% of respondents
- Raised sidewalk just along Jacoby Creek School frontage
- Separated path continuing south of school





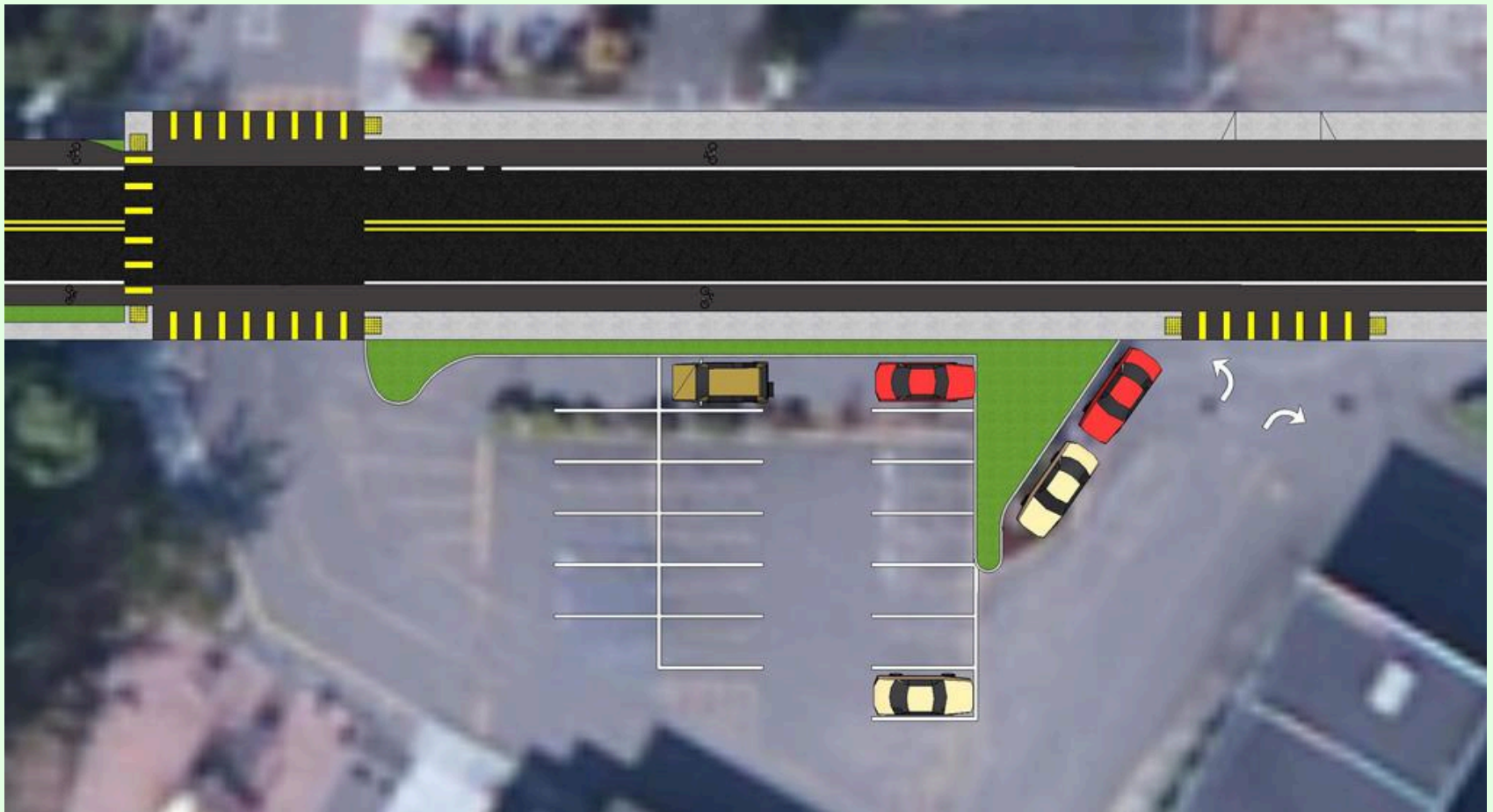

Old Arcata Road Design Project

- Preferred by about 45% of respondents
- Narrow Jacoby Creek Road intersection
- Additional sidewalks
- Safer road crossing
- Aesthetic improvements at City pump house site
- Modifications to Post Office parking lot

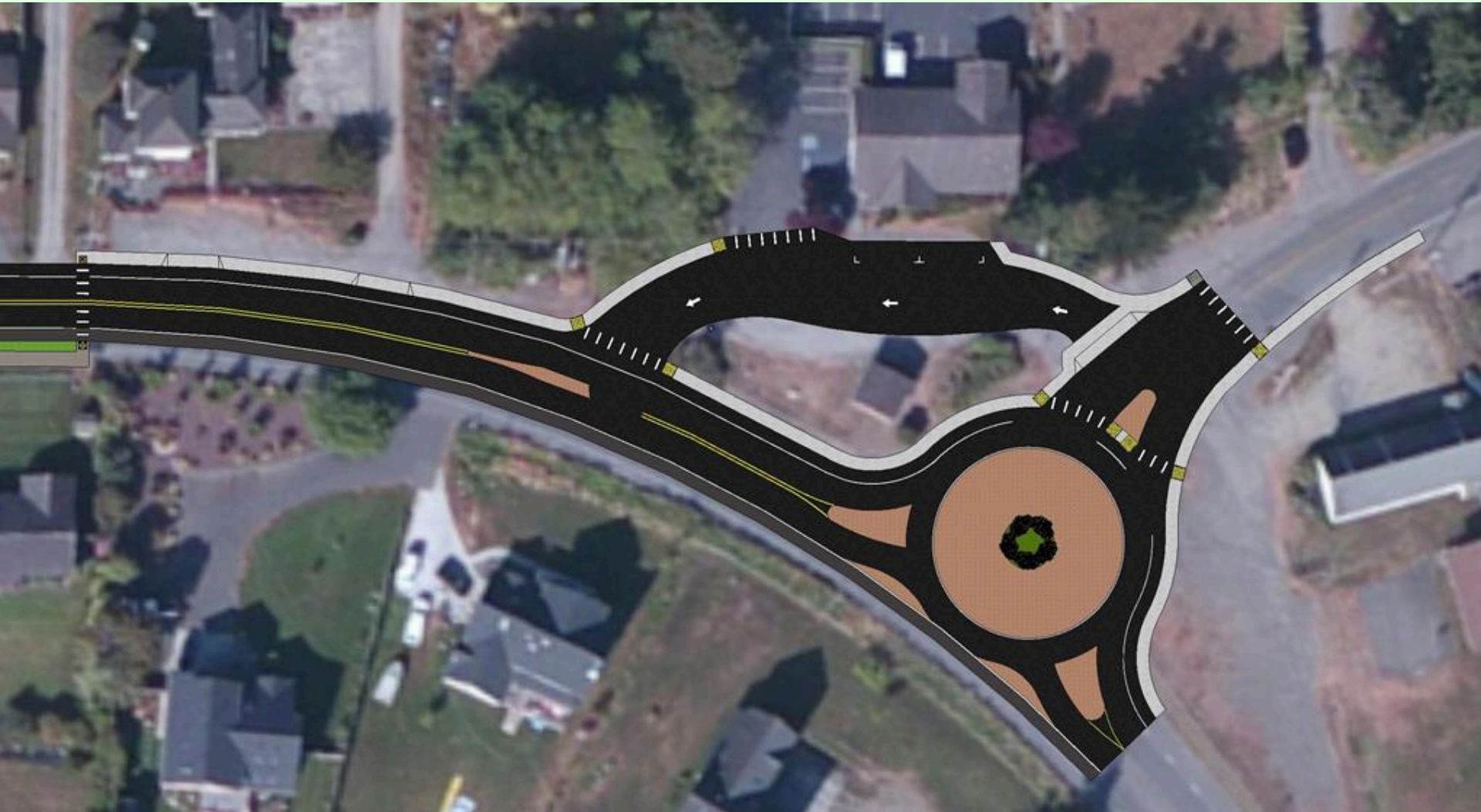
Intersection Concept Alternative #2: Roundabout

- Preferred by about 30% of respondents
- Similar walking facilities as Intersection Concept #1
- Roundabout for traffic calming

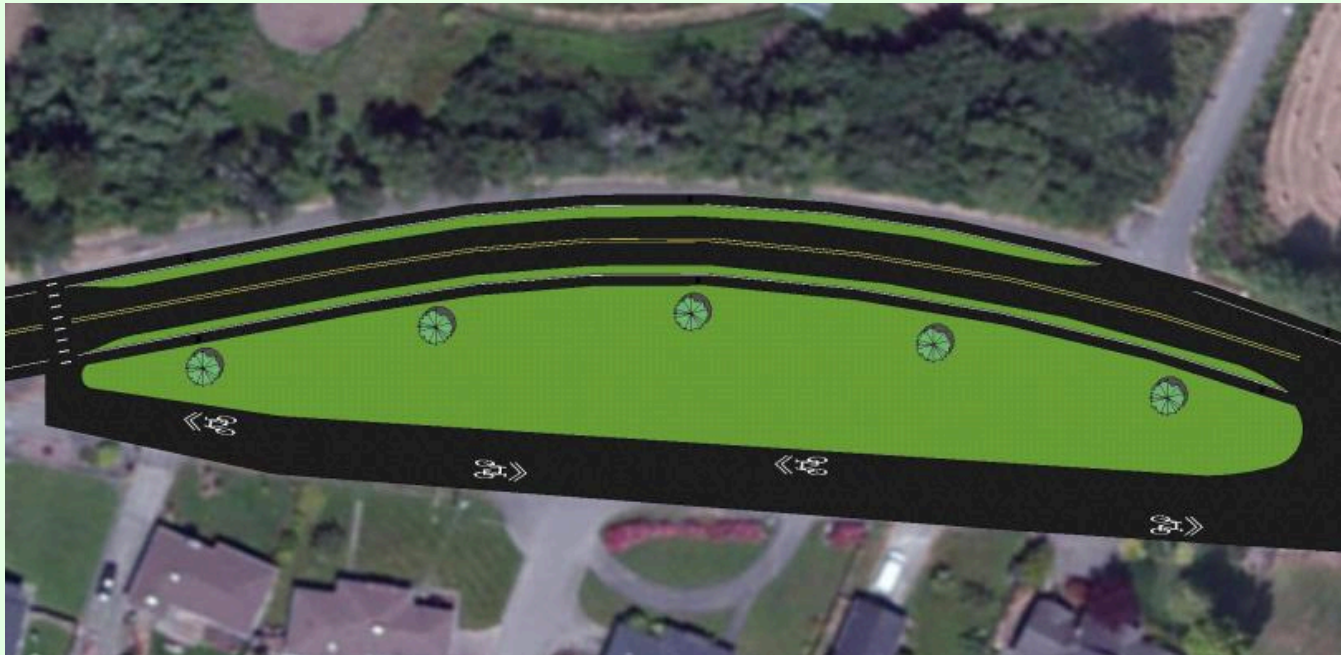
Intersection Concept Alternative #2: Roundabout

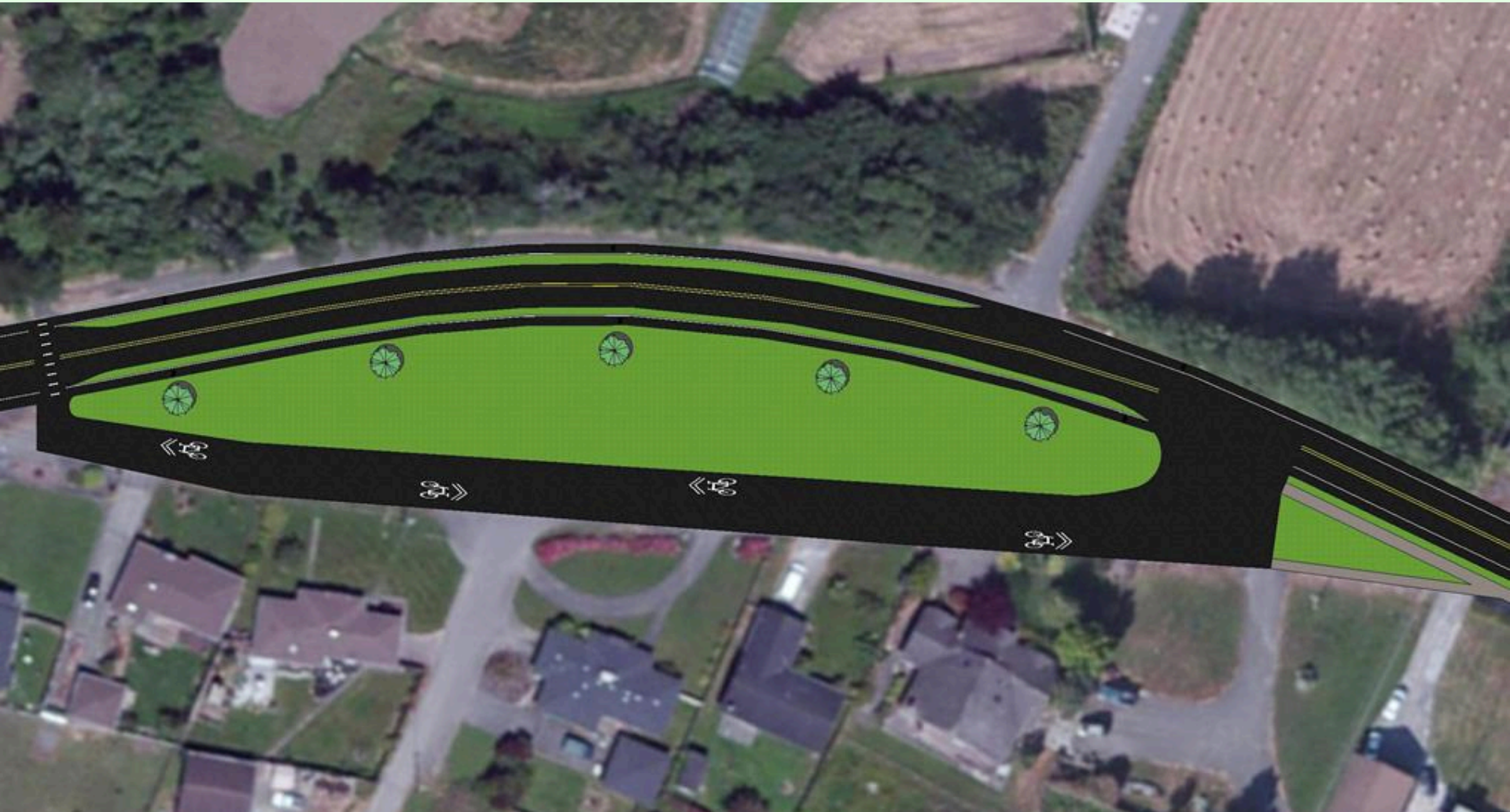
North Segment Concept

- Supported by about 45% of respondents
- Improve existing path to Old Bayside Road
- Formalize shared use for walking and biking along Old Bayside Road
- Create park and school remote-drop off in grassy area

Old Arcata Road Design Project

Overall Desires of Community

- A few individuals wanted to leave the roadway as-is
- Most wanted to see some improvements
- Pedestrian and bike safety are a priority
- Reducing vehicle speed is desired
- Separated path was preferred
- JC School parking needs to be



Old Arcata Road Design Project

- Pedestrian Flashing Beacon at raised crosswalk south of Buttermilk
- Repairs to existing path
- Aesthetic improvements at pump station
- Sharrows on Old Bayside Road
- Explore additional school parking
- Enhance education and encouragement at Jacoby Creek School, Mistwood and Sunnybrae Middle School
